A free veterinary medical camp was arranged by the AWC in the less privileged area of Cholistan, this camp was arranged in collaboration with the Livestock and Dairy Development Department, South Punjab. Under the supervision of Advisor AWC and Senior Tutor CUVAS, Dr. Abdullah Saghir and Veterinary Officer, Dr. Mahar Naeem over 50 undergrad students with the team of L&DD dewormed over 300 animals, treated over 150 animals and vaccinated over 450 animals. The Services that were provided include Deworming, Treatment, Vaccination, General Surgeries and Pregnancy Diagnosis.

Under the guidance of Dr. Abdullah Saghir, Advisor AWC and Senior Tutor CUVAS, and Dr. Mahar Naeem, Veterinary Officer, a dedicated team comprising over 70 undergraduate students and L&DD officials worked tirelessly to provide vital veterinary services to the local community. The camp was a resounding success, with over 420 animals being dewormed, more than 270 animals receiving treatment, and approximately 680 animals being vaccinated against various diseases. Furthermore, the team also performed general surgeries and conducted pregnancy diagnoses, thereby making a tangible difference in the lives of the animals and their owners.
