The event focused on raising awareness about Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) and its management, with a special emphasis on establishing disease-free zones to support the livestock sector.

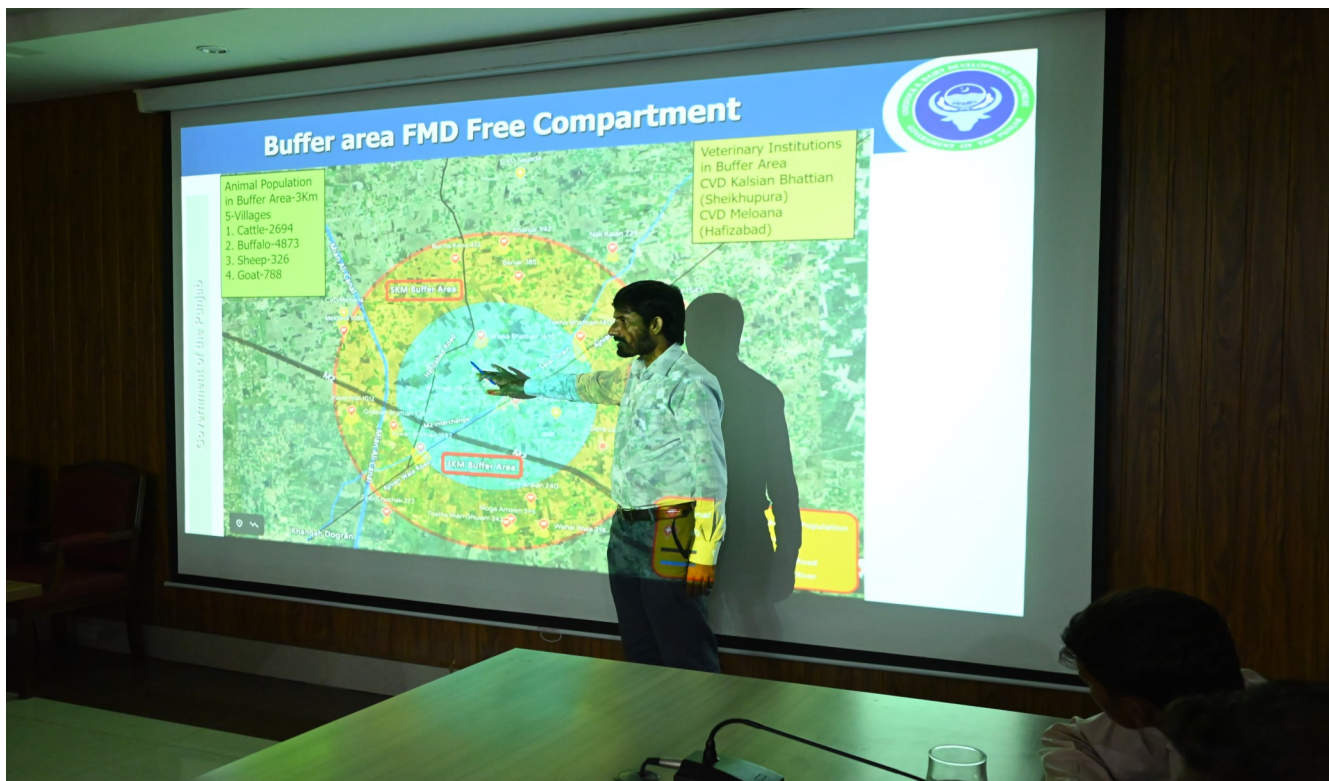
The event featured prominent speakers from the livestock and veterinary sectors. Dr. Abdul Khaliq, Additional Principal Veterinary Officer at the Directorate of Extension, L&DD Punjab, served as one of the key speakers. He elaborated on the FMD DCC (Disease Control Centers) and presented case studies, including those from the Royal Group, discussing the registration process for farmers under the PAITS (Punjab Animal Identification and Traceability System).

Dr. Syed Muhammad Sabtain, Director of Livestock in Bahawalpur, shared his insights on FMD DCC, focusing on how these centers can aid in managing the disease more effectively across regions.

Dr. Rizwana Akram, Director of Livestock in Cholistan, discussed the dynamics of livestock trade and export in the Cholistan region, highlighting challenges and opportunities for improving trade while addressing the risks posed by FMD. The event was attended by various stakeholders, including local farmers, veterinarians, and officials from the livestock sector. Prof. Dr. Mazhar Ayaz, Vice Chancellor of CUVAS, was the

CEWRI PARC Institute | Nano Pipe Responsive Drip Irrigation System

On 28th September 2024, members of the CEWRI PARC Institute visited CUVAS, where a Nano Pipe Responsive Drip Irrigation System was installed for exhibition and research purposes. The CEWRI team included Engr. Zafar Islam, Senior Scientific Officer, and Engr. Shahid Hameed Khalil. The Nano Pipe Responsive Drip Irrigation System is an advanced environmental irrigation technology, introduced in Pakistan exclusively by CEWRI PARC Islamabad. This is the first and only system of its kind in South Punjab, located at CUVAS.

The CEWRI team met with Prof. Dr. Mazhar Ayaz, Vice Chancellor of CUVAS, and discussed the importance of promoting modern irrigation technology in Cholistan to enhance agricultural production while using minimal water. They emphasized that the adoption of high-efficiency irrigation systems is essential to addressing water scarcity issues. Dr.
