CUVAS Observes World Rabies Day 2025 with Awareness Seminar

On October 2, 2025, Cholistan University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences (CUVAS), Bahawalpur, observed World Rabies Day 2025 through a formal awareness ceremony held at the Syndicate Room. The event was organized to highlight the importance of rabies prevention and the role of public awareness in controlling this fatal yet preventable disease.

The ceremony was presided over by the Vice Chancellor, Prof. Dr. Muhammad Mazhar Ayaz, while Dr. Muhammad Sohail Khan Sherwani, Former Director Livestock, served as the Guest Speaker. Faculty members and students actively participated in the seminar.

During the event, an awareness walk was organized in which students displayed placards carrying messages on rabies prevention and pet vaccination. Poster and slogan competitions were also conducted to promote awareness among youth. Expert speakers discussed the epidemiology of rabies and emphasized the significance of the “One Health” approach, linking human and animal health.

Addressing the participants, the Vice Chancellor stated that rabies is a fully preventable disease through timely vaccination, yet thousands of deaths occur annually due to lack of awareness. He reaffirmed CUVAS’s commitment to research, awareness campaigns, and community engagement aimed at eliminating rabies from Pakistan.
